- \* Last October we bought about 6 acres of rough land with only a broken down baseball stadium
- \* In the past year we have had over 70 volunteers help out in developing the land - this includes short-term teams and local Nicaraguan youth groups!
- \* We now have a fence around most of the property! We have done some major repairs to the baseball stadium and have recently been planting a soccer field which will hopefully be done by the end of 2004.



## UPCOMING PROJECTS

In the next 6 months we are hoping to put in a basketball court, a sand volleyball court and start building a Ranchon which will include an open meeting area with a stage and some classrooms that we hope to use for tutoring, classes and a library.
